GENERAL GUIDELINES



ONLINE EVENTS

1. Only one member from a team needs to register for team events.
2. College ID card or letter of authorization from the college (If ID card is not issued) for each participant should be provided as a PDF file.
3. All the members of a team for both offline and online events should be from the same college.
4. The decisions taken by the respective committee and judges will be final under any circumstances.
5. There is no limit to the number of participants or teams from a specific college to participate in any event.
6. No changes will be encouraged and allowed regarding the team after the registration.
7. All participants for management events must have webcam enabled laptop/desktop and ensure stable and secure internet connectivity throughout the event with respect to the event requirements.
8. Participants should be equipped with Web browsers and applications such as Zoom and Google Meet as per the event requirements.

9. We encourage WhatsApp account availability for all the participants as the communication from the event committee may be facilitated via Whatsapp.
10. All the communication and event related announcements will be made via the contact numbers and email information provided. Participants are requested to regularly check their phone and emails.
11. Contact numbers provided by the candidates at the time of event registration must be retained as the participants will be contacted via the same for further stages of the respective events.
12. Any kind of vulgarity or usage of offensive language is strictly prohibited, and any such in stance would lead to disqualification
13. All file submissions such as documents, pictures, videos, audios and PPTs must be in prescribed formats.
15. If any unexpected technical glitch or error occurs during the event, Team Infloré will offer the best possible support. Rest of the factors is participants' responsibility.

16. If an unexpected technical error occur during a performance, the participant is eligible for only one extra chance.
17. Plagiarism checks will be done as per the event requirements and would lead to disqualification if found guilty.
18. Participants must respect the privacy of the links provided during the events. Sharing of the links without a solid reason is strictly restricted.
19. Any sort of unfair or unethical practice and violation of rules will be taken seriously and may further lead to disqualification.
20. Participants are expected to be willing for identity verification anytime during the event by revealing the face or displaying the ID card.
21. The event organizing committee reserves the right to modify and amend the event schedule and platforms for conducting the events. Also, the committee has the sole authority to take decisions if any unforeseen circumstances occur during the events.
22. The organizers hold complete rights over the content shared by the participants during the events.

OFFLINE EVENTS

1. Offline Events include Treasure Hunt, Spot Dance, 3's Football and Corporate Walk.
2. Every Event has a separate set of rules and participants are required to abide by them.
3. All students are required to carry their college identity card at all times within the college premises.
4. Participants must strictly adhere to the general rules of the college and will be liable for the destruction of any property within the campus.
5. The participants must report at the venue 30 minutes before the start of their respective event.
6. Participants are strictly advised to take care of their personal belongings. Organizers will not be held responsible for any damage/loss.
7. Any misbehavior by participants will lead to disqualification of the whole team from the particular event.
8. The committee has the right to change the time and venue of the events.
9. The decisions of the committee and judges will be final at any circumstances.
10. Smoking, drinking and consumption of any such substance is strictly prohibited.

11. Participants are advised to bring their own mobiles, laptops and USB cables as no gad gets or supporting accessories will be provided from the college.
12. Participants should strictly follow the instructions provided by the volunteers during the event. Violation of rules and disobedient behavior will result in disqualification.
13. Rules are subject to change at the discretion of the management/organizers.
14. All Standard COVID Safety Protocols will be followed. Temperature scanning will be done at the point of registration / arrival counter.
